

HIGHVIEW COLLEGE ASSESSMENT AND REPORTING POLICY

Rationale

The student awards system at Highview College exists to recognise student achievements and contributions, and to encourage the growth of students in all areas of the College: academic, studentship, service and co-curricular.

Aims

- To recognise and celebrate high achieving students across all areas of the curriculum.
- To recognise the efforts of students who strive to reach their potential, and give over and above what is normally required.

7-11 Year level Dux and Proxime Accessit Trophies

At the final Year 11 Assembly each year, the Dux of each subject at each year level will be announced:

- calculated on progress in Terms 1-3.
- if the top student is not an A Grade student, no Dux will be awarded.

In addition, the Dux and Proxime Accessit of each year level will be acknowledged. The Dux and Proxime Accessit will receive an invitation to present this achievement as Colours.

- Year level Proxime Accesit (white) 2017 YEAR 7 PROXIME ACCESSIT
- Year level Dux (gold) 2017 YEAR 7 DUX

Studentship Colours

These awards are given to the students in each class who are deemed to be exemplary students – attentive, helpful, participatory, almost always completed homework, tried hard, etc. These awards are calculated on Term 1-3 only and are made on a class-by-class basis, and not across all classes of the same subject. These are made independently of the Achievement awards, so it is possible for a student to receive both types of award, or one award but not the other.

Students who receive the highest number of Studentship Award nominations will be awarded a Studentship Colours.

- Studentship Excellence (gold) 2017 YEAR 9 STUDENTSHIP EXCELLENCE
